All bells, except the Extra Treble, recast by John Taylor and Sons Ltd, Loughborough 1952  
The line that ends "BLESS YE THE LORD" (or "AND BLESS THE LORD") is always on one side of the bell, on the waist.  
The rest of the inscription is on the waist on the opposite side of the bell.  
The "RECAST 1952" (or "2008"), together with the founder's mark and name, are on the shoulder band of the bell.
